Grandfather Powell known as Uncle Joab Was Born in Eastern Tennessee on Clinch river He was a son of Joseph Powell who was of welch decent & of the quaker belefe. Joab Powell married in Tennessee. He married Miss Ann Beeler. They and a host of relatives moved to Missouri in the early 1830 Thirties setteltd in Jackson Co near Lees Summet & Lone Jack. He raised a large family 10 Boys & 4 Girls. Silas Powell was my Father. He Silas married Harriet Rice the year 1845, Dec 18 in Missouri. In the year 1850 Mother & Father started a cross the Plaines with Oxe teems with numerous other relations & friends they were headed for Oregon. They had at that time two children David Crocet & Sarah Elizabeth & Mother had a Brother five years 5 old that she had raised from an Infant. His Mother died when He was Born. His name Charley Rice. Mother and Father got 640 Government land by going that year. They located in the Willamet valley on the Callapooa River 2-1/2 west of Brownsville.

Grandfather Joab Powell came a cross the year 1852 with his famley & a host of relatives With Ox teems They were over six months on the trip & Joab was Captign of the traine. They did not experience any serious Indian truble. He Joab was a Missionare Babtist Preacher. Joab as he was called settled in the forks of the Santa Anm river with all his family and their famleys & friends. There were a host of them. Their trading Post or towns were Scio Lebanon & Albany was 16 or 20 miles a way.

Grandfather was one of the formost persons Organizing the first Baptist Church in his Neighborhood. Called the Providence Church. It was located in half mile of his House. In 1930 I Hiram C. Powell a Grandson of His visited his Old Place & the man that owned it Was a Boheman & He kindly cut a Green Gage Plum tree for me out of the Old orchard that GrandMa & Paw Planted at that time 77 years before & I gathered other wood. there were 18 different relatives represented in the Violine.

Father Silas Powell, my Father lived in Oregon 19 years & during that time He built A House & added a second Part to it that we called the new House. I don't know what year But I remember it well I think I was 4 years old. He built two Barns, Wood shed & Apple House combined & it still stands there yet. House to smoke Meat in & all out buildings & Acummulated 820 acres land fenced & crossed fenced it With railles & it taken a host of them & had a fine 10 Acre Orchard

Off To California

In the year 1869 Father & Mother begin to think of going to Calif. In Company with Uncle Steve Davidson. He Davidson married Father's Sister Marie Powell. It was the last of May or the first of June that we made the start & It was the 9th of November when that trip ended up in San Luis Obispo

on the costwf (???) on the Green Valley to Uncle Steves place. We Brought with us 100 Head cattle &Thirty head Horses three wagons. But alas the Sad Part of it all was we did not have Father with us when

We got there He taken sick at the foot of Pachaco Pass on the West side next to Gilroy. The Grave yard was moved & We lost his Grave. We lived on Uncle Steves Place the winter of 1870 & 1871. Then Bought a 160 Acres on Cayucos Creek. Lived in that Neighborhood 40 years & Accumulated 1800 acres of land & lived in 4 different homes on this Property.

All us Children were Born in Oregon exept David Crocket and Sarah Elizabeth they were Born in Missouri.

Pps 345 & 346

DAVID C. POWELL Was born in Jackson County, Missouri, July 22, 1847, being the eldest of eleven children in a family of four sons and seven daughters. His father's name was Silas Powell, and his mother before marriage was Harriet Rice. His grandfather was the distinguished Baptist preacher, Joab Powell, well known in Missouri, the principal field of his labors. When the subject of this sketch was three years of age, his parents emigrated cross the plains to Oregon, finding there a home, where they resided until 1869. There he passed his years of youth, obtaining his education in the schools of that State, and becoming familiar with the business of farming and the management of stock. In 1869 his parents decided to seek a more Southern clime, and removed to genial California. While on the long journey he had the sad misfortune to lose his father, who died in Santa Clara County, and the family continued their way to San Luis Obispo. David C. Powell being the eldest of the children, upon him devolved the duty of caring for the others. Settling upon a ranch he entered into the busiless of farming, dairying, and stock-raising, with success, his farm comprising an area of 920 acres, which he owns. In 1871 he came to reside at his present home, which belongs to his mother, now Mrs. Shipp. In this place are 327 acres, and the fine improvements shown in the engraving on another page.

Mr. Powell, was married November 21, 1877, to Miss Martha C. Petty, a native of Missouri, and two boys bless the union. Both Mr. and Mrs. Powell are fond of society and enjoy greeting their friends at their hospitable home.

Mr. Powell, while actively and strictly attending to business, finds time to attend to his duties as a prominent citizen. Politically he acts with the Democrats, and was in 1876 chosen to the honorable ofifice of Justice of the Peace, which office he now holds.

Steemer Boat landed at Sansimmion ten miles north of Cambria. & they Came out to the Green Vallie
to Uncle Steve Davidsons Place (?) Uncle Steve & Our folks brought them out here & they lived on
Uncles place for most two years. Uncle Ralph put in some crop while there.

The reason they made the change was on acount of Aunt Barbvias Helth. She had been Bed fast at that
time three years & they thot the change would do her good & it did altho she was Bead fast about (?)
over anothers year & finaly She got strong & enjoyed health. Slone finely bought a Place over on
Santa Rosa Creek of Mose Phillips The Place that the Smelting works of the Ochanich quick Silver
mine now stands. Then the family moved

On to the Cayucos Creek into Mother's Old House. Mother & Shipp being married at this time, the
beginning of 1874 Mother & Shipp had moved on to his Place on the Villi Creek. Brother Dave had
rented the Hardie Pland & Docia Bro Charley & I & Uncle Charley Rice lived with Him Docia was our
House Keeper & We helped milk the cows for we run a 40 Cow dary & went to school. The Sloans
stayed on the Cayucos Creek till the later part of 1875. Shipp Sold his Place on the Villi creek to Sloan

& they moved over there & Mother & Shipp Moved on to Mothers Place on the Cayucos & Shipp Bought a half interest in Mothers Place there being 320 Acers of it. Shipp lived there till he died in 1882.

Uncle Ralphs famley lived on this Place till a bout on Oct 1902 When George Bishop rented the Place Uttleyh owned it at this time Sloans Isot it thru indebtedness. At this time these were onley Uncle Ralph Neal & Jim

that were making it their home. Uncle Ralph & Jim rented the Old Swaine Place on house up on Old Creek. It belonged to the old man Cass at this time. They lived there for several years till finely -Uncle taken sick & came to our House & stade for several days & Ellie his Girl came up from San Luis & taken him there. & he most died of this spell He after that went to Los Angeles to live with his daughter Addie. She always was good to him finely. He could stay there no longer & was taken to San Luis to Ellies & then after wards was Put in County Hospittle & died there Being Eighty-three 83 years old He never was a very strong robust management

Aunt Barvria dide at the Ranch on Villi creek the year 1890 I think about August from that time on Uncle & Neley & Jim lived on the ranch. Addie lived with them a while. The famley being scatted Addie married Mark Chamber bout 1892. When Uncle & famley moved to Calif they had six Children
